The retreat will feature **Patricia McBroom**, a published writer and former professor of women's studies. Pat was a member of MPC for 13 years until she became a Zen practitioner in the year 2000. She will talk about what it means to find the "inner" Buddha – to awaken – and how that creates equanimity in troubling times. In wide-ranging discussions, we will consider the remarkable similarities and universal wisdom of Christ's messages and those of the Buddha. We will see how their teachings can illuminate each other. By viewing the parallels together, we may have the experience of seeing something new in a familiar saying.

The day will include the practice of Zen meditation, as Buddhism emphasizes its importance in having direct experience, gaining insight, and discovering your true nature. To round out the day, two other guests will lead us in Tai Chi movement and spontaneous Zen art.
