### **FRIDAY EVENING: DESSERT PARTY & MIXER, 7:30 pm at group campsite #45**

### **SATURDAY EVENING: Campfire, 7 pm at group site #45 (S'mores supplies provided; please feel free to bring more, plus your favorite roasting stick)**

### **SUNDAY AFTERNOON: BURNING MARSHMALLOW, 2 pm**

This is MPC's version of Burning Man: our way of welcoming the campground community into the cabin community. All attendees are invited to roam around the cabin area and visit MPC cabin hosts for some type of activity at each of the participating cabin sites. Fun for all ages!
